The CDC (Center for Disease Control) recommends a flu shot for nearly everyone. Children 6 months and older through adults should get the shot. Particularly anyone in the high-risk category (children less than 5, adults over 65, anyone living in a long-term care facility, and those with a chronic illness) should be vaccinated. It's advised to get the shot before the end of October, but it is not too late! You may want to consider getting one even though it's the end of January.


