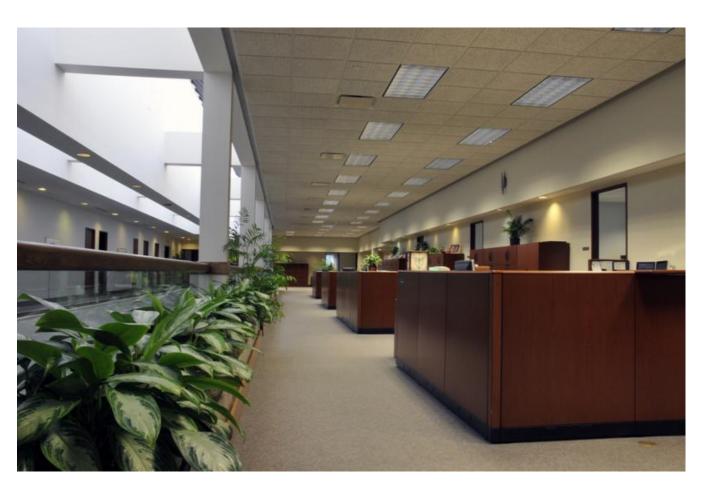


Giving Your Office a Natural Glow



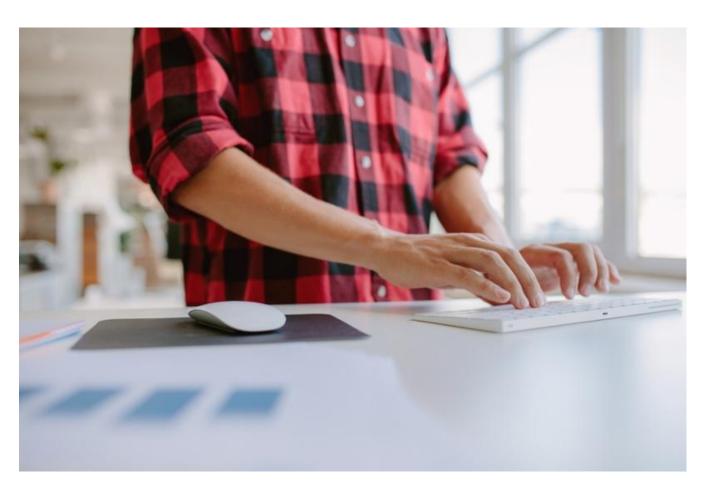
